

Larry Nowels is a consultant working with the Hewlett Foundation and the U.S. Global Leadership Coalition on foreign aid reform and budget issues. He also serves as the U.S. Policy Director for ONE. Previously, he was a specialist in foreign affairs at the Congressional Research Service. During his thirty-three year career at CRS, he wrote extensively on U.S. foreign assistance policymaking, including the congressional role in legislating and overseeing American foreign aid programs. Nowels further served on detail assignments to the House Budget Committee and the House Foreign Operations Appropriations Subcommittee. Upon leaving CRS in mid-2006, he served as a consultant to the Helping to Enhance the Livelihood of People Around the Globe (HELP) Commission. Following the 2008 election, Nowels served on President-elect Obama's transition team examining U.S. foreign assistance agencies.
